REMARKS:

A 'Murder' charge was laid and is presently before the courts with reference to the murder during May involving the death of a 24-year-old woman.

An armed robbery at knife point resulted in apprehension of the two persons responsible, who are awaiting court appearance. Three persons were arrested for Robbery with Violence, all of whom had criminal records, and disposition is still before the courts. A Robbery with Violence involving the theft of a wallet from a man in his 50's is under investigation; but because the victim was attacked from behind, it is not likely the assailant can be identified.

A Rape investigation resulted in the arrest of the suspect, who is presently released on bail and will be appearing at a later date to face the charge.
