REMARKS: One fatality - child got off bus, ran out onto street in front of bus and was hit by a passing car. No blame attached to driver. Safety Council acknowledges "fatality free" Safe Driving Week in December and Municipality will be receiving certificate in recognition of this.

Two armed robberies during January, both at knife point wherein the culprit stole the money from the cash register by threatening the attendant. One involved a Chinese corner grocery which lost \$62.00 and the second a Mini Mart store reported to have lost \$40.00. There does not appear to be any suggestion that the same culprit was involved in both instances.

One complaint of rape is under investigation, whereby the complainant was forced to submit at knife point. A similar attack on a woman in Vancouver took place and it is possible that the same culprit was responsible for the attacks. The G.I.S. are liaising with City Police.

One robbery with violence whereby the complainant had been drinking considerably and met a man at the bar, went for a drive and was robbed of \$30.00. Complainant not definite what area of city this took place and apparently not able to identify culprit.
