2. Re: Agreement to Construct a Watermain Under Railway Land  
Big Bend Area

The proposed construction of a water distribution system in the Big Bend area is contingent upon the execution of an agreement between the Canadian Railway Company, the B.C. Hydro and Power Authority and the Municipality. The agreement would allow the Municipality to construct and maintain an 18" diameter watermain five feet below the base of rail as shown on the attached sketch.

The water distribution system was approved in the 1973 budget. The funds are being carried forward for construction in 1974.

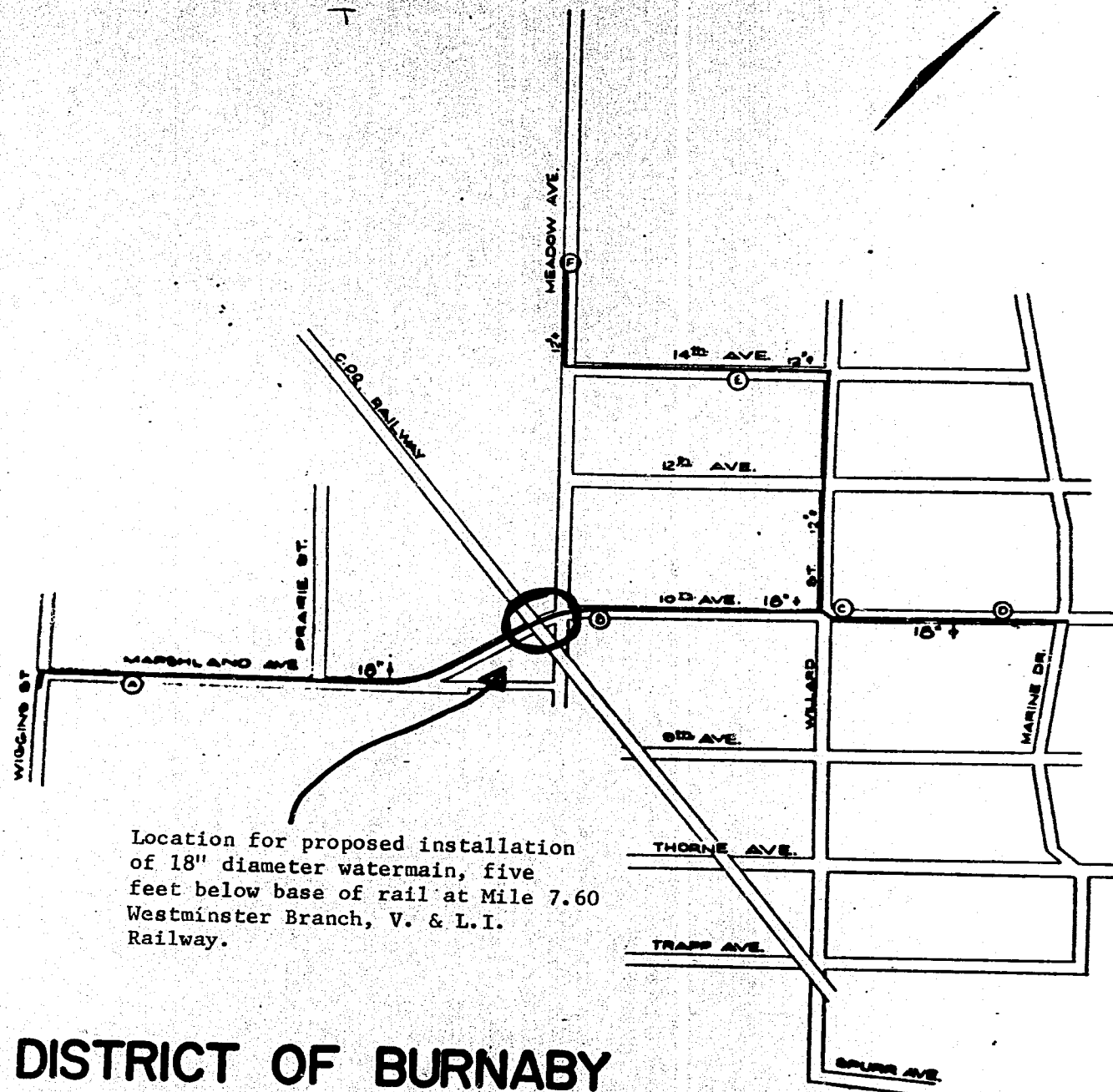
Council will recall that tenders for the pipe that is required for the system were approved on February 11, 1974.

The documentation fee would be ten dollars. Permission for the watermain to remain under the railway would cost the Municipality ten dollars per annum.

The Engineer recommends that the agreement be executed on behalf of the Municipality.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT authorization be given to execute the agreement on behalf of the Municipality.
