REMARKS:

The increased motor vehicle accident rate commented on last month has not slowed in spite of more enforcement and prosecutions to cut down those caused by speed or alcohol. There were 3 more fatal accidents in July resulting in 5 deaths, for a total of 11 fatal accidents, this year as compared to 3 to date in 1973. The statistics indicate that the driving habits of the motoring public are deteriorating for reasons difficult to determine.

With the exception of B. & E. offences, crime too is increasing at a faster rate than the last two years. There were 9 armed robberies reported during the month; 3 from individuals; 4 from service stations; 1 from a delivery man and 1 from a restaurant at gunpoint. Of two incidents of rape reported, 1 was proved unfounded and in the second, a charge has been laid against an individual who was out on bail for a similar offence.

The June By-law fine totals were not available last month but are now shown above.
