Appearing on the Agenda for the March 25, 1974 meeting of Council is a request from Mr. Josiah Wood to appear before Council on March 25, 1974 for the purpose of appealing the Licence Inspector's decision to not renew the business licence for Johnson & Franklin Wholesale Distributors Limited.

Council on March 11, 1974 considered a detailed report which stated the reasons for the position that has been taken by the Licence Inspector with regard to his decision to deny the firm's request for a renewal of licence. Council subsequently directed that the Solicitor for the firm be advised that unless an appeal is heard on or before April 8, 1974, the Municipality will proceed with legal action against Johnson & Franklin Wholesale Distributors Limited for operating without a business licence.

Representatives from the R.C.M.P. and the Licence and Legal Departments will be at the meeting on March 25, 1974 to answer any questions that Council may have regarding this matter.
