Section 52 of the "Municipal Act" provides:

"52. (1) The Council shall, for the annual elections in each year and at other times as required, appoint

- (a) a Returning Officer;
- (b) the place at which nominations will be held;
- (c) the place or places at which polls will be
- opened in case a poll is required;

 (d) such Deputy Returning Officers as are required who will preside at the respective pollingplaces, or delegate to the Returning Officer the power to appoint such Deputy Returning Officers, and otherwise arrange for the holding of the annual or other election.

(2) No person shall be appointed by the Council or by the Returning Officer for the purposes of an election who has been or is employed by any other person in or about the election."

It is recommended that the Municipal Council give consideration to the adoption of the following motions:

- (a) <u>THAT</u> James Hudson, #1003-4960 Sanders Street, Burnaby, B.C. be appointed Returning Officer for The Corporation of the District of Burnaby for the 1974 Annual Election;
- (b) <u>ThAT</u> nominations for the 1974 Annual Election be held in the Burnaby Hunicipal Hall Council Chamber, 4949 Canada Way, Burnaby, B.C.;
- (c) <u>TEAT</u> in case a poll is required for the 1974 Annual Election same be opened at the following places:
