Subject: Edmonds House - Completion of the Lower Floor Harrison/Kiss, Architects

At a meeting on 7 August, 1974, the Parks & Recreation Commission approved the plans for completion of the lower floor of Edmonds House, and at the Council meeting of 3 September, 1974, Council authorized the calling of tenders for the completion work. The estimate of the cost of work at the time of calling tenders was placed at \$90,234.

Construction bids were received by the Purchasing Agent in an open meeting at 3:00 p.m., 25 September, 1974, and are as follows:

Receipt of the above bids was reported orally to the Parks and Recreation Commission at a special meeting at 7:00 p.m., 25 September. The Commission approved the recommendation of the Chief Building Inspector to accept the bid of Bengal Construction Co. Ltd., subject to the Chief Building Inspector being satisfied that the firm can handle the work competently.

The undersigned has checked on the background of this firm. Bengal Construction has been in business for the past four and one-half years and currently has on hand an alteration project for the West Vancouver School Board, for whom the Architect is Robert Harrison. In addition, the firm has two alteration projects on hand for the Federal Department of Public Works--one in the main Post Office and the other in rented office accommodation on Granville Street. The value of these three jobs is around \$390,000. Besides these, the firm is said to have other smaller projects on hand. Bonding for the firm is handled by Leslie, Wright & Rolfe Ltd. and undertakings for bonding were submitted with the tender. The undersigned has spoken to a principal of the firm and is satisfied that the firm understands the work to be undertaken in Edmonds House.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that construction contract be awarded to Bengal Construction Co. Ltd., 3525 Normandy Avenue, in the amount of \$89,795, based on the specifications and drawings of the work prepared by Harrison/Kiss, Architects, dated September 1974.
