COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

R.C.M.P. TRANSPORT \$131,958

Major offences during October included 10 Armed Robbery reports, three of which involved use of firearms. Only one arrest was made, but that arrest resulted in the solving of seven previous Armed Robberies in Burneby for which this same individual was responsible. Additionally, he was found to be responsible for a Bank Robbery in New Westminster, one in Surrey and two in Coquitlam.
