COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major offences during October included 10 Armed Robbery reports, three of which involved use of firearms. Only one arrest was made, but that arrest resulted in the solving of seven previous Armed Robberies in Burnaby for which this same individual was responsible. Additionally, he was found to be responsible for a Bank Robbery in New Westminster, one in Surrey and two in Coquitlam.

Of the four reported Rape offences, one was learned to be unfounded and no arrests were made but all continue to be under investigation.

The single traffic fatality involved a vehicle going out of control and over an embankment, resulting in the death of the passenger.
