

Re: By-Law No. 6627
"Burnaby Municipal Hall Parking Regulation By-Law, 1975"
(Item 44, Report No. 43, June 10, 1974)
(Item 22, Report No. 57, September 3, 1974)
(Item 6, Report No. 82, December 9, 1974)

Council, at its meeting of September 23, 1974, adopted By-Law 6525, "Burnaby Municipal Hall Parking Regulation By-Law 1974" and on December 16, 1974, adopted Amendment By-Law, No. 6587, which, essentially, clarified the original By-Law.

Appearing on the Agenda for the February 10, 1975 meeting of Council is By-Law No. 6627 required because the existing By-Law does not provide for regulation or parking in an area set aside for the exclusive use of Municipal staff operating out of various satellite offices (Parks, Engineering, Fire, etc.) and requiring short duration parking while visiting the Hall. Signs in this particular area will be posted to read "Visiting Municipal Staff Parking Only".

On the outer edge of the Employee parking lot there is a line of stalls set aside for assignment to specific members of staff and in conformance with the By-Law is signed as "Staff Parking Only". The sign seems to create confusion for employees not entitled to park in the reserved stalls and it is proposed that the By-Law and signs should refer to "Assigned Staff Parking Only".

The proposed By-Law, as prepared by the Municipal Solicitor, meets with the approval of the Purchasing Agent who administers the Parking Regulation By-Law.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT By-Law No. 6627, "Burnaby Municipal Hall Parking Regulation By-Law, 1975" be brought forward.
