

Re: Vending Machine Contract

Following is a report from the Parks and Recreation Administrator regarding the proposed renewal of a vending machine contract with Vancouver Enterprises Ltd.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT authorization be given to execute a two year contract from May 16, 1975 with Vancouver Enterprises Ltd. on the basis of the commissions as outlined in the body of the Administrator's report.

The Vending Machine Contract with Vancouver Enterprises Ltd. ends on May 14, 1975 and the following proposal from that company for a further two year contract has been received.

Restaurants Ltd.


The Vancouver Enterprises Ltd. have fulfilled the terms of their contract in a satisfactory manner in the past and the
