COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Criminal Code statistics continue to show an increase month by month in comparison to those of last year. Although the total number of reportable accidents are up, the number of persons injured declined for the second month in a row.

Major offences during the month included an arrest of a man fleeing from an armed robbery of a Mac's Milk store. A search of his vehicle disclosed he was in possession of a machette, 4-in. blade knife, a handgun and a pellet rifle. He is also wanted by neighbouring police forces for investigation. Two other armed robberies reported during the month are still under investigation, along with a rape investigation, a purse snatching, assault with intent, and a robbery with violence concerning a number of youths.

The traffic death involved a two-car accident wherein the passenger of a vehicle was killed when that vehicle was struck from behind.
