COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

This new type of monthly report will enable Council to compare crime and traffic statistics with the same month last year and the total to date each year for easy recognition of trends in the broad areas listed. *Enforcement index means the total prosecutions for hazardous moving violations divided by the number of fatal and personal injury accidents. A desirable index is considered 15 or above; this month ours was 12.7, attributed to poor driving conditions in January.

Major crime during the month of January included one murder in which a woman was shot to death in her apartment. A man has been arrested and charged with this offence.

There were 6 armed robberies; one by a lone bandit from a bank netted the thief \$1,500, and the other five targets were service stations and small grocery stores. In addition, there were 4 robberies with violence, one of them being from a 14-year-old boy by a 16-year-old.
