COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS: The increased crime and accident statistics which were so noticeable last year are continuing and you will note that Criminal Code offences are up 11.3% to date this year, and total accidents 13.8% for the same period. Major crimes during the month of February included an unusual non-capital murder wherein the 17-year-old victim was killed with arrows from a crossbow. Two men have been charged with this offence. There were six armed robberies committed during the month; one from a bank, another of a credit union office, and the other four were either service stations or small grocery stores. Arrests have been made and charges laid in connection with the two most serious offences. In the case of the credit union robbery, the C.P.I.C. computer system was instrumental in a speedy and successful investigation.

Although the accident total is up to date this year, February accually saw improvement as the number of injury accidents were reduced in February compared to last year. ou con
