Re: BURNABY DOG TAX & POUND & ANIMAL REGULATION BYLAW 1972, BYLAW NO. 6191 TICKET INFORMATION FORM - DOGS ON LEASH (Item 7, Report No. 67, October 15, 1974) (Item 14, Report No. 70, October 28, 1974)

Council, at its meeting of October 15, 1974 received Item 7, Report No. 67 which, with other related items, raised the matter of instituting a violation notice and amending the subject bylaw to read "Every owner shall keep his dog on a leash while on a highway or public place." At that meeting Council adopted the foregoing amendment and tabled the matter of a violation ticket and provision of a minimum fine pending receipt of further information.

At its meeting of October 28, 1974, Council received Item 14, Report No. 70 and, with other amendments to the bylaw, provided for fines of \$15.00 for a licenced dog and \$30.00 for an unlicenced dog as regards failure to keep a dog on a leash while on a highway or public place.

Following is the Municipal Treasurer's report, together with a proposed ticket information form.

The penalty for an unlicenced dog does not include the cost of a licence. Licences may be obtained at the Animal Shelter, 3202 Norland Ave., Burnaby, or the Municipal Hall, 4949 Canada Way, Burnaby.

Should the person to whom this summons is directed desire to plead "not guilty" to the charge, he is requested to notify the Pound Enforcement Officer of the District of Burnaby well in advance of the date set for appearance in court. This may avoid the possibility of an adjournment. He may be reached by telephoning 294-7330.

The court may issue a warrant for the arrest of any person who fails to answer ticket information.
