COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major crime during August included a Murder of a male person. Investigation is continuing and it appears the murder is linked with an underworld killing. Other serious crimes investigated included a rape complaint and 14 robberies, eight of which involved the use of firearms.

The three traffic fatalities during August involved the overturning of a mail truck, a pedestrian colliding with a motor vehicle and a motorcycle accident.

The Detachment is still 5 members under strength as of August 31, as departing members have not yet been replaced by transfer in.
