Re: Cameron Street at North Road

With reference to the above and inter-office communication dated February 21, 1975, I wish to advise that enforcement action was carried out at the above location on the dates indicated, with results as shown hereunder:

19 FEB	1 Man	7:30 A.M. - 8:30 A.M.	6 Charges

It would appear that violators will continue to make right turns off North Road onto Cameron Street in order to avoid the heavy congestion at Austin and the Lougheed Highway.

Our Traffic Section has had to alter shift schedules in order to provide adequate enforcement at Cameron Street and North Road, and it is felt that other complaint areas during early morning commuter traffic have had to be ignored in order to attend at this problem intersection.

The majority of violators are residents of Coquitlam and Port Moody who are very quick to show their displeasure at the restricted turning movements at this intersection which, in their opinion, is only to satisfy a minority group in the Sullivan Heights area.
