As part of the requirements for rezoning, the British Columbia Telephone Company was to provide the Corporation with rights-of-way for municipal services. These new rights-of-way will make an existing right-of-way redundant and they have asked that it be released. This would appear to be a reasonable request. There is also a "Crossing Agreement" dated May 12, 1921 on one of the existing lots. Among other things, this agreement allowed the then owner, a Mr. Martin, to construct a crossing over the curb and to put up a \$10.00 deposit for damages. Needless to say, this agreement is now out of date and the B. C. Telephone Company wishes it released.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute the necessary document to release the redundant right-of-way and the crossing agreement.
