On 7 July 1975, Council received from the Municipal Clerk a Certificate of Sufficiency covering the paving of the subject lane as a local improvement by the petition method.


Following is a cost report which is required by Section 601 of the Municipal Act:

Owners' share of the cost of the work	\$ 2,970.00
Estimated lifetime of the work in years	10
Frontage tax levy	5 instalments of \$.5036 per taxable front foot
