SUBJECT: LANE AT THE REAR OF 100 BLOCK FELL AVENUE

The captioned lane is the subject of a petition to be presented to Council on 5 August, 1975.

The opening of this lane does not fall easily into the existing policy, i.e. that the Corporation will construct lanes if the abutting properties present a valid petition for capping the lane. To open this lane also requires that both Pandora and Dundas Streets be opened for one-half block so as to give entrance and egress to the lane.

The Engineering Department would like to look at this problem in concert with other Municipal Departments and report later.
