Reference the request from the Alpha Secondary School to hold a walkathon on Sunday, May 25, 1975.


We have checked the requested route and have found that there are good off-the-road walking facilities along most of its length. The only area requiring a degree of caution is that section along the Willingdon Avenue overpass of the Trans Canada Highway. Pedestrians should be particularly careful when crossing the on and off ramps at this interchange.

The above consideration has been discussed with the R.C.M.P who concur with the following recommendation.
