SUBJECT: Underground telephone facilities on the south east corner of Central Park

On Council agenda for July 7, 1975 appears a letter from the Land Management Branch of the Department Lands, Forests and Water Resources requesting comments on an application by the B.C. Telephone Company to bury underground facilities on the south east corner of Central Park. On May 29, 1975 the Central Park Committee dealt with the request of the B.C. Telephone Company per their letter of May 9, 1975, copy attached. The Committee were advised by a joint Burnaby, Vancouver Parks and Recreation Staff Report that there was no objection to the application, and it was recommended that it be approved subject to the approval of the Department of Lands, Forests & Water Resources.

It was duly moved and seconded that the Committee approve the recommendation subject to appropriate landscaping being carried out by the B.C. Telephone Company to the satisfaction of the Burnaby Parks and Recreation staff, carried unanimously.
