  - (2) The Council shall arrange for the holding of a vote and shall determine the day on which the poll will be held and the polling day.
  - (c) ... where a by-law is to be submitted for the assent of the electors, shall be not less than ten days and not more than one month after the day upon which the by-law receives third reading."
