Council has received correspondence from residents in the southern part of Burnaby expressing concern over the rumored improvement of Rumble Street to a four lane street.

The Planning Department submits the following points of information on Rumble Street for Council:

- 1) Rumble Street traverses several elementary school catchment areas and provides access to the residential neighbourhoods along the entire south slope area of Burnaby.
- 2) Rumble Street is not proposed as a truck route.
- 3) Rumble Street will continue to function as a residential collector street. Its proposed standard of development is 36 feet which provides only one travel lane in each direction with parking.

- 4) Rumble Street will not continue across Boundary Road into Vancouver as currently developed. The revised plan for the Champlain Heights area has eliminated the current link to Boundary Road at Rumble Street.
- 5) Any improvements to Rumble Street in future will be made via the Local Improvement procedure and will include sidewalks and boulevard tree planting.
- 6) Rumble Street is not in any current Local Improvement Program.
