COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major offences included the arrest of an individual on a charge of murder plus an attempted murder charge, reference a shooting incident at a local hotel; Two separate charges of attempted murder were laid against a man, involved in a domestic dispute; Attempted murder charge laid after an investigation into a stabbing incident at a private party; An attempted murder charge was laid after a report of attempted strangulation was investigated at a local hotel.

Four reports of rape were investigated and charges have been laid in two of the incidents.

Seven robbery incidents reported during the month (4 involving use of firearms) are under investigation and to date charges have been laid in one instance.
