COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:
 One of the major incidents during August was an Armed Robbery of a bank, which resulted in exchange of gunfire between police and bandits. One of the bandits was wounded by a police bullet - full recovery. Two persons were charged with the robbery and also with attempted murder. Additionally, charges are also laid for previous unsolved armed robberies. Court appearance is still pending.

Other robberies during the month included a purse snatching for which a juvenile was arrested; 3 Armed Robberies of small commercial outlets which are still under investigation; and a robbery from person by three males which remains unsolved.
