RE: EASTBURN NEIGHBOURHOOD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM


Work on the Neighbourhood Improvement Program has continued during the past few months. This has involved setting up an advisory resident planning committee, which has met weekly, sending out questionnaires to all residents, investigating community problems and establishing community goals. The attached report has been prepared by the resident committee in conjunction with planning staff, and proposes a number of improvements to the neighbourhood.

The purpose of this draft report is to initiate community response. The report is a preliminary statement only at this point.

Four thousand copies are being distributed, including all residences in the neighbourhood. Four public meetings are being held on October 12, 13, 18 and 20th (locations noted in the attached report). Following these meetings, necessary changes will be made to the proposals. Discussion will then be held with the CIP committee, the Parks Commission, the School Board, as well as all Municipal Departments.

After the proposals have been reviewed by these bodies, a final report will be submitted to Council.
