Re: LETTER DATED APRIL 7, 1976 FROM THE LOYAL ORANGE ASSOCIATION
REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO CONDUCT A PARADE

Appearing on the agenda for the April 20, 1976 meeting of Council is a request from Miss E.M. Corbett, Secretary of the Committee for the Loyal Orange Association, for permission to conduct a parade on July 10, 1976. Following is a report from the Municipal Engineer on this matter.

The R.C.M.P and Engineering Department have no objections to use of the route as described in the correspondence for parade purposes. Further approval, however, is required from the Provincial Department of Highways. Permission to use Confederation Park must be obtained from the Parks and Recreation Commission.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the request from the Loyal Orange Association for permission to conduct a parade on July 10, 1976 be approved subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) The parade is conducted in accordance with Section 23 of the Streets and Traffic By-Law; and
 - (b) That approval be obtained from the Provincial Department of Highways; and
2. THAT the subject correspondence and this report be sent to the Parks and Recreation Administrator so that the Administrator's decision regarding the requested use of Confederation Park can be sent directly to the Association.
