Re: R.C.M.P. PERSONNEL ON TRAFFIC DUTY
(Item 4, Manager's Report 80, December 13, 1976)

When Item 4, Manager's Report 80 was considered by the Municipal Council on December 13, 1976, an inquiry was raised as to how many traffic officers we have on duty "on the average". The report had made reference to the fact that we have as many as eight members on duty during the day shift (8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.), nine members on the evening shift (4:00 p.m. to midnight) and as few as one but usually two on the midnight shift (midnight to 8:00 a.m.).

The Officer-in-Charge of the Burnaby Detachment advises in response to this inquiry that, when taking into account those who are not rotated into the shift, for reasons previously identified, we are left with an average of five to six personnel on the day and evening shift. The graveyard shift remains as formerly stated.
