COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Four reported robberies from persons, all involving the stealing of cash. Included was a purse snatching from a 77-year-old woman (charges laid) and robbing of \$56.00 from a paper boy. No other charges have been laid to date.

Investigations into complaints of rapes and indecent assaults totalled four and involved 9, 14, 23 and 50-year-old females. There was not sufficient identification or evidence to lay any charges.

March is the first month we introduced the municipally supplied prisoner meals concept and the comparable cost figures with last year for the same month are \$238.00 this year, and \$849.00 last year.
