COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The Municipal manpower contract was officially increased from 191 to 197 effective September 1st. Some positions were filled for a portion of the month, but with transfers out the strength at the month end was 190. However, the Municipality is credited with man-day shortages for each day an authorized position is vacant.

Charges were laid in connection with numerous Indecent Assaults upon females which occurred over a period of time. One arrest was made in connection with an Armed Robbery of a drive-in theatre. Three other Armed Robberies remain under investigation. A 14-year-old juvenile was charged with Robbery With Violence from a 12-year-old (\$15.00 in cash involved).
