COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major offences included the investigation of a kidnapping and attempted extortion which resulted in the arrest of the culprit. Although the victims were confined for several days, they were unharmed.

Nine armed robberies were investigated during December, 7 of which involved use of firearms. Three arrests were made to date, with one of the persons being charged with seven robberies previously investigated. Of the two Rape complaints, one was unfounded and the second is still under investigation with no arrests to date.

The 4 traffic fatalities during the month all involved pedestrians. Two teenagers were struck and killed by a speeding vehicle on Loughheed Highway. The other two persons were struck and killed when crossing the street. Charges have been laid in all instances.
