COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Of four rape reports during February, two were unfounded; charges were laid in one case; the other is still under investigation.

Two 'Armed Robberies' investigations involving the use of firearms resulted in charges being laid in one case. There was a rash of seven robberies involving other offensive weapons, where relatively small amounts of money were stolen (corner groceries and the like). To date, charges were laid in one instance only, with the remainder being under investigation. Of three 'Purse Snatching' investigations charges were laid in two instances.

Three culprits were apprehended inside premises into which entry had been gained by one having 'picked' the lock.
