COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The month of October recorded the second traffic fatality in Burnaby this year. It involved an elderly lady who walked across a busy street without any apparent regard for traffic and was struck down. No criminal charges are contemplated.

Major crimes during October included arrests of 2 persons after a robbery at a local drive-in. The culprits were later identified as being escapees from prison. Charges were laid in connection with a restaurant robbery involving \$70.00; an arrest was made after a \$3,000.00 bank robbery; 3 were arrested for robbery from person; 4 arrested in a separate robbery from person.

Four other reported robberies from person; a service station armed robbery and two auto thefts at knife point remain under investigation. Five reports of indecent assault on female, one rape and one attempted rape continue under investigation.
