COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during July include four Armed Robberies where firearms were used, including a \$4,700 bank robbery. All instances continue under investigation with no arrests to date.

Investigation into two reports of Rape showed both were unfounded. Three reported robberies from persons continue under investigation; two involving thefts of articles of clothing from victims, and one of a purse snatching and beating in a park by two male persons.
