Re: R.C.M.P. MONTHLY REPORT

Attached is the report of the Officer in Charge, Burnaby Detachment, R.C.M.P., covering the policing of the Municipality for the month of April, 1976.

With reference to the information on overtime as noted in the last paragraph of the report, it should be mentioned that the 3,139.5 figure is the time and one-half computation, i.e. actual hours overtime worked reverts to 2,092 hours.

If we take the Detachment's actual strength at month end which was:

$$\begin{aligned} & 187 \\ & \quad \times 8 \text{ hrs. per day} \\ & = 1,496 \text{ hrs. per day for the Detachment} \\ & \quad \times 22 \text{ working days in April (excluding 2 days off per week)} \\ & = 32,912 \text{ total hours.} \end{aligned}$$

Percentage of overtime worked of total hours by Detachment (rounded off to nearest "0"):

$$\frac{2,090}{32,910} \times 100 = 6.4\%$$

PLEASE NOTE: Of the 2,092 hours referred to, 1,088 hrs. are compensating hours for working statutory holidays in April, which leaves us with 1,004 overtime hours worked. This, then, puts the percentage at approximately 3.3%.

## COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during April included laying of charges for attempted murder when the accused attempted to run down his victim with his motor vehicle.

A person is charged with the rape of a 19-year-old girl. Three investigations of indecent assault (two under 6 yrs. of age) have not resulted in charges being laid. Included in the 11 robbery investigations was a purse snatching from a 74-year-old woman; robbery of a food delivery boy; and a drug oriented robbery from a person. To date no charges have resulted but investigation continues.

The Criminal Code, Federal and Provincial statutes files are up over last year's total by more than 600 for the same period. Traffic accidents are down slightly less than 100, with no traffic deaths to date compared to 2 last year.

Headquarters instructs, effective April 1976, Municipalities be informed of total overtime hours incurred by R.C.M.P. personnel working in Burnaby during the month. The total for April, 1976 was 3,139.5 hours.
