SMOKING REGULATION BY-LAW

Appearing on the agenda for the September 7, 1976 meeting of Council is a letter from Mr. Larry Wanjoff in which he recommends, as President of the United Non-Smokers Society, that smoking regulations be established in Burnaby by the adoption of an independent by-law (as opposed to having such regulations legislated by amendment to an existing by-law).

Although staff at this time is intending to recommend that a ban on smoking in stores be brought forward as an amendment to By-Law No. 6904 - "Burnaby Fire Prevention By-Law 1968", it would be desirable to hear Mr. Wanjoff's arguments for an independent by-law before any further action is taken on this matter. It is therefore suggested that Mr. Wanjoff's comments be referred to staff for consideration in connection with a report that will be submitted on September 13.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT comments made by Mr. Wanjoff relative to his proposed adoption of an independent by-law to regulate smoking be referred to staff for study and comment; and
2. THAT Mr. Wanjoff and Mr. A. MacDonald, Manager of the Burnaby Chamber of Commerce, be advised that smoking regulations will be the subject of a report, and consideration by Council, on September 13, 1976.
