SUBJECT: DRIVEWAY ACCESS TO SERVE 6961 MARY AVENUE (STELP)

Mr. Stelp appeared before Council at its meeting of 30 August, 1976, requesting that a curb crossing be provided to the location on his property which he has been using as a parking area since the former carport was enclosed and made part of the house.

On the other side of Mr. Stelp's property there existed sufficient room to gain access to his backyard, but in order for him to do so it would have been necessary to demolish an outside structure in the backyard.

In view of the foregoing, I have directed the contractor to install the curb crossing at the location requested by Mr. Stelp.
