**COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:**

Major incidents during the month included a murder charge and an attempted murder charge being laid, after an investigation into a shotgun shooting in a Burnaby residence.

November recorded the 3rd and 4th Traffic fatalities for 1976:- a 13-year-old youth rode his bicycle through an intersection and was struck down, and the second death involved a motorcyclist crashing into the side of a motor vehicle. On the positive side, the number of injuries, the property damage and number of accidents are down over last month and are all down considerably over the year, as recorded above.
