In May, 1976, Mr. Stevan A. Pelke was advised in writing that his application for a chauffeur's permit to drive a taxi in Burnaby had been refused by the R.C.M.P. Council's consideration of Mr. Pelke's appeal on May 25 resulted in an authorization to grant a chauffeur's permit to him on the understanding that the matter would be reviewed by staff and a report submitted to Council in six months time.

The Officer in Charge, Burnaby Detachment, R.C.M.P. advises that Mr. Pelke was issued a taxi permit and proceeded to drive for Bonny's Taxi on a part-time basis for about two or three months. Mr. Pelke was recently discharged and is no longer employed by that company.

Mr. Pelke applied for a taxi permit in the City of Vancouver on December 1, 1976. The application was denied.

Mr. Pelke is not now operating a taxi in Burnaby, and no further action is required on this matter at this time.
