Re: ELECTION SIGNS

The purpose of this report is to provide information on political signs which will be erected throughout the municipality in connection with the election in November.

The Burnaby Sign By-law includes provision for election signs under Clause (9) of Schedule No. 1 which reads as follows: "Temporary signs pertaining to campaigns, drives or events of political, civic, philanthropic, educational or religious organizations, provided that the permission of the Council must be obtained to erect such signs upon or over public property and provided further that such signs shall be removed within 3 days after the event".

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve the erection of political signs on municipal property by all the participants in the forthcoming municipal elections subject to the meeting of the provision of Clause (9), Schedule No. 1 of the Burnaby Sign By-law as noted above; and
2. THAT a copy of this report be sent to the presidents of each of the participating political associations, including independent election participants, in the municipality.
