Re: PROPOSED DEMOLITION OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY
LOT 7, EX. W. 75', BLKS. 1, 2 & 24, D.L. 6, PLAN 4155
9753 CAMERON STREET

Following is a report from the Land Agent regarding the proposed demolition of property which is located at 9753 Cameron Street.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the subject buildings be demolished and the property on which they are situated be cleaned up.

The subject property was purchased for the construction of Reese Street to link Cameron and Sullivan.

There is a small two-roomed house with a lean-to kitchen in a state of disrepair and no sewer connection. There are also two small sheds in a dangerous condition situated approximately 150' from the front property line. The Health Department has advised that they have had many complaints regarding these buildings.

By this memo, we are requesting that permission be given to demolish these buildings and clean up the property.
