
This bridge is used by pedestrians to gain access from the Charles Rummel Recreation Centre area to the tennis courts north of Eagle Creek and to the bus stop on Lougheed Highway.

The bridge has been deteriorating over the past two years and has recently shifted, resulting in a slope to the bridge deck which is difficult to negotiate under wet conditions.

The staff feel that this bridge should be replaced immediately and the Parks and Recreation Commission, at its meeting of April 6, 1977 approved the expenditure of \$1,000 from the 1977 Minor Development Account.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council approve the expenditure of \$1,000 from the 1977 Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Program Minor Development Account for the replacement of the foot bridge in Charles Rummel Park, prior to approval of the 1977 Annual Budget.
