Re: LETTER AND PETITION FROM J. P. DAEM REQUESTING PEDESTRIAN CROSSING - CANADA WAY AND WAYBURNE DRIVE

Appearing on the agenda for the December 12, 1977 meeting of Council is a letter and petition from J. P. Daem requesting a pedestrian crossing at Canada Way and Wayburne Drive. As noted in the following report from the Municipal Engineer, this matter has been dealt with previously by the Traffic Safety Committee.

Attached are minutes from the March 21 and August 2, 1977 meetings of Council which summarize the actions taken in the past with respect to the concerns that have been expressed by Mr. Daem.

The Engineering Department is now conducting a further study of the crossing at Wayburne and Canada Way, and a full report on the results of this study will be referred to the Traffic Safety Committee at its monthly meeting in January. As normally this information and a recommendation would be forwarded to Council by the Committee, it would be appropriate for Council to defer its further consideration of this matter until that time.

- 2. THAT a copy of the letter be referred to the Traffic Safety Committee for further study and comment.
