COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during the month included two attempted murder charges being laid, after an investigation involving a severe beating.

The month of December showed a vast decrease in the motor vehicle accident, persons injured, and property damage categories over December of the previous year, as recorded above. Likewise, traffic fatalities totalled 5 versus 20 during 1975.
