COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The second homicide of 1977 was investigated during September, when a young lady was found murdered in her apartment. An arrest was made within ten hours and the person is now before the courts.

Seven robberies under investigation included robbery of a corner grocery by a young lady; robbery and assault of a young lady enroute home from a bus stop; and two robberies and assault of youths at a local shopping centre. Two suspects were apprehended and are before the courts in connection with one of the robberies; the remainder remain under investigation.

A report of rape was proven unfounded and two reports of indecent assault remain unsolved.
