

Re: 1978 LOCAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BOND STREET DETWEEN SUSSEX AND ELSOM (Item 34, Supplementary Report No. 57, August 29, 1977)

Following is a report from the Director of Planning regarding a correction to an item which appeared in the 1978 Local Improvement Program which Council approved on August 29, 1977.

During its regular meeting on August 29, 1977 Council approved a list of streets proposed for initiation in the 1978 Local Improvement Program.

The works proposed for Bond Street between Sussex and Elsom included a 28 ft. wide pavement with curbwalks on both sides of the street.

Bond Street is currently developed to an interim "capped" pavement standard between Nelson and Willingdon Avenues which includes the section of Bond approved for local improvement by Council. Bond Street serves as a neighbourhood collector and supports a B. C. Hydro bus route (Willingdon #30) in both directions.

A recent review of the program by the Engineering Department, prior to advising the Corporation's Consultant on the design aspects, indicated that the description of the "works" pertaining to the street width was in error. The street width appearing on the list should have been 36 feet instead of 28 feet.

RECOMMENDATION:

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It is recommended

THAT Council approve the proposed amendment to the street width for Bond Street between Sussex and Elsom from 28 ft. to 36 feet.
