COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during June included robberies of four business establishments. Three instances of armed robbery of a person were reported, including a woman who was robbed and beaten when she surprised a thief in her home early in the morning. Investigations continue in all cases. There have been no arrests to date.

We received six complaints of rape this month. Charges have been laid in one incident, 3 have been proven unfounded, and the other two remain under investigation.

Escapes during the month numbered 12.
