ATTENDANCE OF PARKS AND RECREATION ADMINISTRATOR AT THE CANADIAN PARKS/RECREATION ASSOCIATION ANNUAL CONFERENCE

AUGUST 14-18, 1977

At its meeting of April 20, 1977, the Parks and Recreation Commission approved the attendance of the Parks and Recreation Administrator at the Canadian Parks/Recreation Association Annual Conference in Toronto, Ontario, August 14-18, 1977.

This Association is the only national organization dealing with the problems of Municipal Parks and Recreation delivery systems. This year the Conference will deal with matters of national interest such as: planning for the future, standards, open space planning, underwater parks, waterways, urban waterfront development, recreation for seniors, etc.
