SUBJECT: LICENCING OF DISCOTHEQUES

At the meeting of 30 May 1977, Council directed staff to review and report on provisions of the Zoning By-law and the Burnaby Discotheque Regulation By-law as they relate to the operation of discotheques in the Municipality, and to advise Council of any proposals to establish further such facilities prior to the issuance of a licence.

On 1 June 1977 (Item 8, Manager's Report No. 41) the Director of Planning reported that staff had met with a group who were examining the feasibility of opening a discotheque in a portion of the McPherson Winter Club, 7325 McPherson Avenue. An application for a discotheque licence for this location has now been received from Mr. Harry Trarup.

Unless directed to the contrary, I do not intend to issue this licence until Council has received and deliberated staff's report on the operation of discotheques, which should be available in about four weeks.
